Qualifications:

- I. Medical Officers who have registered/ are registerable in the Sri Lanka Medical Council according to the Medical (Amendment) Act.No.28 of 2018.
OR
- II. Medical Officers with valid full registration of Sri Lanka Medical Council (SLMC).
AND
- III. Doctor of Medicine (MD)/ Master of Surgery (MS) in the relevant specialty with Board Certification of Post-Graduate Institute of Medicine (PGIM), University of Colombo, Sri Lanka [Appendix I of the Gazette (Extraordinary) No.1883/17 dated 11.10.2014 of the Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka].
AND
- IV. Certificate of Good Standing from Sri Lanka Medical Council (SLMC).

Age Limit:

Shall not be less than 30 years and not more than 45 years.

Salary Scale:

MC 1-2 – Step 01 Rs. (161,140 - 12 × 4,850 - 219,340)

(Placement will be made at the initial salary step of the MC 1-2 salary scale.)

General Conditions:

All applicants must,

- I. Be citizens of Sri Lanka.
- II. Possess the physical and mental fitness required to effectively discharge the duties of the post and to serve at the General Sir John Kotelawala Defence University Hospital.
- III. Be of excellent moral character.
- IV. Have completed all requisite qualifications by the closing date for applications.
- V. Be entitled to receive pay and allowances in accordance with the regulations of the Ministry of Health.
- VI. The employee's contribution to the Employees' Provident Fund (EPF) is 10%, and the University will contribute 15% to the EPF and 3% to the Employees' Trust Fund (ETF), subject to any revisions that may be introduced by Parliament by law.
- VII. Duly completed applications together with certified copies of relevant certificates, should be sent by registered post to the **“Executive Director, General Sir John Kotelawala Defence University Hospital, Werahera”** on or before **31.05.2026**. The post applied for should be clearly indicated in the top left-hand corner of the envelope.
- VIII. General Sir John Kotelawala Defence University reserves the right to shortlist prospective applicants. All recruitment shall be conducted by means of a structured interview process, in accordance with the prescribed procedures.
